a fish. Use different concepts to

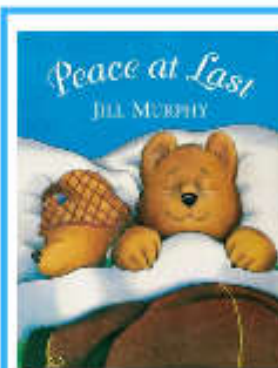

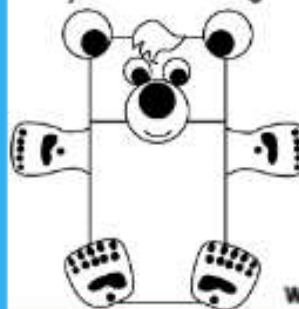
